

#### The Easy

- Creating a PDF plugin
- Editing localization variables
- Formatting text
  - Titles
  - Body text
  - Note labels
  - Lists



#### The Not So Easy

- Finding the file to edit
- Configuring fonts
- Formatting tables
- Formatting the TOC



#### The Stupidly Hard

- Setting up pages
- Changing header and footer information
- Formatting the index
