






- Client based on DITA Open Toolkit's code









REMOTE TRANSFORM

Source files in a version control system

Move to DITA Open Toolkit



Remote execution → Jenkins

- Distributed builds
 - Efficient queue management



CREATION OF IBM WORKFLOW MANAGER

Started as a side project, I wanted an easy-to-use Web UI for people to use our Jenkins Transform service.











SHORT-TERM GOALS

- Lower the entering cost (learning/setup)
- Scheduled process

LONG-TERM VISION

- Apply DevOps to technical documentation
- Completely hide/automate the build process from writers
- Give them an end-to-end editing/publishing experience

TO THE CLOUD






100% CLOUD BASED


- Standalone servers were hard to manage/update
- Moved all transforms to containers.



100% WEB BASED

- We wanted people to contribute from anywhere, without installing any editing software
- Edit online links were born









AUTOMATED INSTANT BUILD

- Advanced auto trigger feature
- Analyzes and tracks content
- Knows exactly what to run as soon as a file is edited in any GitHub repositories or FileNet.





INTEGRATIONS

- Ease: Slack notification
- Value: Accessibility check
- Collaboration: Box upload
- Translation
 - DITA/HTML/SVG instantly translated
 - Supports for Machine translation and Human Translation


TWO CLICKS TO GET STARTED
